

## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors [because prices can vary].

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL</b> [Funeral director's charges only]	From <b>£3050.00</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	<b>£876.00</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death [within 15 miles of the Funeral director's premises] into the Funeral director's care, during normal office hours.	<b>£300.00</b>
Care, preparation and dressing of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.	<b>£749.00</b>
Providing a suitable coffin made from oak veneer.	<b>£475.00</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment during normal office hours.	<b>No Charge</b>
At a date and time, agreed with the Funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium [within 15 miles of the Funeral director's premises] in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	<b>£650.00</b>

<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b> [Funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee]	<b>£2175.00</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends choose not to attend the cremation.	
Cremation [Funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee]	<b>£2175.00</b>

<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. <sup>1</sup> [This fee which is sometimes called the interment fee is the charge made for opening and closing a new or existing grave.]	
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	<b>£1145.40 - £2171.60</b>
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
In this local area, the typical cost of an attended cremation for local residents is:	<b>£1425.00</b>

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
The Funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional additional products and services, or to arrange for a third party to supply them on your behalf e.g.	
Additional mileage [price per mile]	<b>£2.00</b>
Additional transfers of the deceased person [e.g., to their home, to a place of worship etc. - price per transfer]	<b>£360.00</b>
Collection and delivery of ashes [within 15 mile radius]	<b>No Charge</b>
Embalming	<b>£POA</b>
Funeral officiant [e.g., celebrant, minister of religion etc.]	<b>from £200.00</b>
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	<b>£POA</b>
The Funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.
